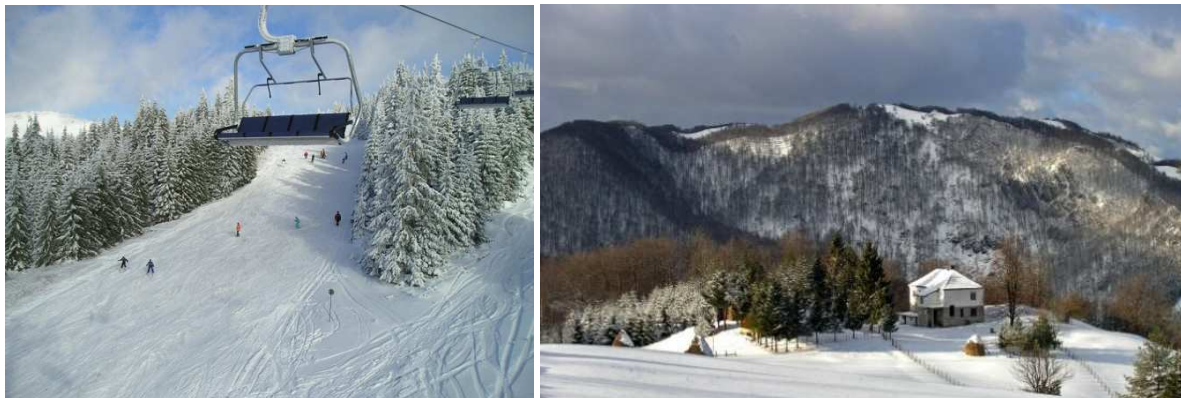
Official Language: Serbian
